Registration and the ordering process are as follows:

Please follow these instructions:

1. Visit <https://blueakai.schoolbitez.com>
2. Click "Create New Account"
3. Fill out the required information to create your account. **IMPORTANT:** Please select the grade your child/children **will be going** into for 2025-2026 school year.
4. You may set up all your lunch participants under one account.
5. Once registered, you can easily browse each day's menu items and place your lunch orders up to the entire length of Summer Explorations. There are no minimums required to place an order.

Downloading the App

A **Schoolbitez.com** app is available to download for iOS users. After downloading the app, please enter **EMS-CAMP** as the registration code. Through the app, you will have access to all the same features as the website.

Orders are placed weekly and may be placed by 4:00 p.m. on Sundays. For example, an order for the week of June 23rd must be placed by 4:00pm on Sunday, June 22nd. Orders may be canceled up to 7:00 a.m. on the delivery date. Please contact Blue Akai by e-mail or text for assistance with cancellations and late orders.

Please note: Blue Akai lunch meals will not arrive with utensils, so students should bring these daily. EMS will have compostable backups if utensils are forgotten at home.

The ordering process is managed through <https://blueakai.schoolbitez.com> only; Summer Explorations lunch orders may not be placed directly with Blue Akai (the restaurant).
